



Epilepsy is a neurological condition characterized by sudden, uncontrolled electrical activity in the brain. The Florida Department of Health's Epilepsy Services Program offers care and assistance to individuals with epilepsy. The program supports the development and expansion of services for the case management, diagnosis, care, and treatment of epilepsy, including necessary medicines, medical procedures, and services that improve patient outcomes.

The Epilepsy Medication Assistance Program can provide medication for eligible Florida residents. Contracted providers can assist individuals with the application process.

Eligibility

To qualify for the Epilepsy Medication Assistance Program, individuals have to provide evidence of the following:

- Proof of permanent Florida residency, such as:
 - Florida driver's license or identification card
 - Current utility bill in the individual's name with a valid Florida address
 - Current Florida voter registration card
 - Current school record or registration certificate from a Florida k-12 school
- Diagnosis of epilepsy or have had a seizure or suspected seizure and require services to diagnose epilepsy
- Have no insurance or other medical service coverage
- Have assets less than \$2,500 in private funds, bank accounts, or assets, other than a homestead
