Services Program

The Epilepsy Services Program is a unique client collaboration that provides patient assistance and referrals, education, and prevention services to the public. The program works to increase the independency of individuals with epilepsy, awareness of epilepsy, research about the condition, and understanding the neurological functions in individuals with epilepsy. This is to attain a positive effect in the care and treatment of individuals with epilepsy.

The Florida Department of Health's Epilepsy Services Program contracts with organizations located throughout the state, ensuring every county resident is afforded the opportunity to access services.

Services Include:

- Low or no cost medical care
- Epilepsy self-management and education support
- Screening and diagnostic testing
- Mental health support
- Assistance with vocational rehabilitation, housing, food, and medicines

Eligibility and Registration

To register for program assistance, contact your county's contracted provider and complete their registration process. Required eligibility information will include:

- Evidence of a seizure or suspected seizure requiring services to diagnose epilepsy.
- Proof of permanent Florida residency, such as:
 - Florida driver's license or ID card
 - Current utility bill in the individual's name with a valid Florida address
 - Current Florida voter registration card
 - Current school record or registration certificate from a Florida k-12 school
